## PARENT/PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- ✓ I will not engage in arguments, use foul or abusive language, or exhibit any acts of verbal or physical aggression.
- ✓ I will exhibit good sportsmanship to make this an enjoyable experience for all participants.
- ✓ I will treat managers, coaches, umpires, fans, and players in a respectful manner.
- ✓ I will not harass players, coaches, or fans of the home or visiting teams.
- ✓ I will place the physical well being of all players ahead of the desire to win.
- ✓ I will adhere to and require compliance with measures to maintain an environment free of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco use.
- ✓ A member of my teams coaching staff has reviewed with me the GGBL rules, particularly the General Rules for Coaches, Players, Parents, and Team Participation, and I will adhere to these rules.

I hereby agree to abide by the above code of conduct and understand that failure to abide by such may result in suspension or expulsion from the GGBL.
